





Women's Army Auxiliary Corps (WAAC)

With war looming, U.S. Rep. Edith Nourse Rogers of Massachusetts introduced a bill for the creation of the Women's Army Auxiliary Corps in May 1941. Having been a witness to the status of women in World War I, Rogers vowed that if American women served in support of the Army, they would do so with all the rights and benefits afforded to Soldiers.

Spurred on by the attack on Pearl Harbor on Dec. 7, 1941, Congress approved the creation of WAAC on May 14, 1942. <u>President Franklin D. Roosevelt signed the bill into law</u> on May 15, and on May 16, Oveta Culp Hobby was sworn in as the first director. WAAC was established "for the purpose of making available to the national defense the knowledge, skill, and special training of women of the nation."

DID YOU KNOW?


WAAC adopted Pallas Athene, Greek goddess of victory and womanly virtue - wise in peace and in the arts of war - as its symbol.

Pallas Athene and the traditional "U.S." were worn as lapel insignia. Cap insignia was an eagle, adapted from the design of the Army eagle. The WAAC eagle, later familiarly known as "the Buzzard," was also imprinted on the plastic buttons of the uniform.

Victory in Europe Day, generally known as V-E Day, VE Day or simply V Day, was the public holiday celebrated on 8 May 1945 to mark the formal acceptance by the Allies of World War II of Nazi Germany's unconditional surrender of its armed forces. The formal surrender of the German forces occupying the Channel Islands did not occur until the following day, 9 May 1945. It thus marked the end of World War II in Europe.

The term VE Day existed as early as September 1944, in anticipation of victory. On 30 April 1945, Adolf Hitler, the Nazi leader, committed suicide during the Battle of Berlin. Germany's surrender, therefore, was authorized by his successor, *Reichspräsident* Karl Dönitz. The administration headed by Dönitz was known as the Flensburg Government. The act of military surrender was signed on 7 May in Reims, France^[4] and on 8 May in Berlin, Germany.


Celebrations: Upon the defeat of Germany, celebrations erupted throughout the western world. From Moscow to Los Angeles, people celebrated.

In the United Kingdom, more than one million people celebrated in the streets to mark the end of the European part of the war. In London, crowds massed in Trafalgar Square and up the Mall to Buckingham Palace, where King George VI and Queen Elizabeth, accompanied by Prime Minister Winston Churchill, appeared on the balcony of the palace before the cheering crowds. Princess Elizabeth (the future Queen Elizabeth II) and her sister Princess Margaret were allowed to wander incognito among the crowds and take part in the celebrations.

In the United States, the victory happened on President Harry Truman's 61st birthday. He dedicated the victory to the memory of his predecessor, Franklin D. Roosevelt, who had died of a cerebral hemorrhage less than a month earlier, on 12 April. flags remained at half-staff for the remainder of the 30-day mourning period. Truman said of dedicating the victory to Roosevelt's memory and keeping the flags at half-staff that his only wish was "that Franklin D. Roosevelt had lived to witness this day." Later that day, Truman said that the victory made it his most enjoyable birthday.

Massive celebrations also took place in Chicago, Los Angeles, Miami and especially in New York's Times Square

What is the Voice of Democracy Program?

Since 1947, the Voice of Democracy has been the Veterans of Poreign Wan" (VFW's) premier scholambip program. Each year, nearly 27,000 high school students compete for more than 52 million in scholarships and incentives. Students compete by writing and recording an audio easily on an annual patriotic theme. This year's theme is, "Is America Today Our Poreistikens" Vision?"

Why Should I Enter?

Prices and scholarships can be swarded at the Post, District, state and actional level. Department (State) winners receive an all-expense-paid trip to Washington DC, to tour the city, be honored by the VFW and its Auxiliary and receive their portion of \$171,000 in national awards, the top scholarship being \$35,000.

The Rules

Who can enter?

The Voice of Democracy is open to students in grades 9-12 by the Oct. 31 deadline who are encouled in a public, private or perochial high achool or home study program in the United States, fix territories and possessions; or dependents of U.S. military or civilian personnel in overseas schools. Although U.S. citizenship is not required, students must be leavial U.S. permenent residents or have applied for permanent residence (the application for which has not been deaded) and intends to become a U.S. citizen at the earliest opportunity allowed by law. Foreign exchange students, students age 20 or over, GED or Adult Education. Students are ineligible.

What do I need to enter?

Record your original 3-5 minute (+ or - 5 second mex.) and/o essay on a firsh drive, or other electronic device. You will submit the recording, typed easy and this completed entry form. Provide these items to your achool/group competition or VFW Post for judging. In addition you can submit your emailed entry form, essay, and andio file to the VFW Post upon approval. You must be the sole author of your easily. Inappropriate use of ChatGPT or or other AI tools is not allowed. The recording must be in your own voice and in English. Hearing/speech impaired students should enail the Voice of Democracy National Office at youthscholauships@wfw.org for special instructions. No music, singing, poetry or sound effects are allowed. The body of the easey must not identify you in any way, (including, but not limited to your name, school, city, state, race, or national origin) although the recording & typed easy should be labeled with your name, to show ownership.

Where Do I Submit My Entry?

All entries begin at the VFW Post level. The only exception is where schools/classes/youth groups have large numbers of students and while to conduct their own connetition, submitting one winner for each 15 students to the VFW Post. Individual students may solanit their entry directly to the Post. Entries sent to VFW National will be returned. One winner for every 15 entries. from each Post advances to District and one District winner advances to the state (Department) competition. What is the Deadline for My Entry?

All entries competing at the Post level must be in the hands of that VFW Post by midnight, Oct. 31, 2024. It is the responsibility of the student to meet this deadline by submitting their entry to the proper location by ensuring it is a participating Post.

What Are the Judging Criteria?

Originality is worth 50 points:

Treatment of the theme should show imagination and human interest.

Content is worth 35 points:

Clearly express your ideas in an organized manner. Fully develop your theme and use transitions to move amoothly from one idea to another.

Delivery is worth 35 points:

Speak in a clear and credible manner.

Student Entry Deadline: October 31, 2024

Patriotic Written Essay Competition Grand Prize: \$5,000 Award

What is the Patriot's Pen Program?

Conducted nationwide, this VFW-sponceed youth emay compatition gives students an opportunity to write emays expressing their views on an annual patriotic theme. We invite you to join the more than 73,000 students who participated last year in this context.

Why Should I Enter?

Prizes and scholarships can be awarded at the Post, District, State and national level. Department (State) winners receive a portion of \$55,000 in national awards. National Winners will receive at least \$500. The first-place cational award is currently \$5,000.

The Internal Revenue Service requires a recipient awarded more than \$599 be given Form 1099 identifying the proceeds as tauble income. This may require the winner to provide their social security number.

How Does the Contest Work?

All entries begin at the VFW Post level. The only exception is where schools/classes/youth groups have large numbers of students and wish to conduct their own competition, submitting one winner for each 15 students to the VFW Post. Individual students may submit their entry directly to the Post.

The contest consists of four levels. The first level (entry) is sponsored by VFW Posts. Post winners advance, one for every 15 entries, to the VFW District (regional) level where the one first-place winner is advanced to the VFW Department (stats) level. The first-place winner at the Department level is then advanced into the VFW national competition.

Who Can Enter?

Patriot's Pen is open to 6th, 7th and 8th-grade students encolled by the Oct. 31 deadline in public, private or perochial schools in the U.S., its territories or its possessions; or dependents of U.S. military or civilian personnel in oversees schools. Home-schooled students also are eligible. Although U.S. citizenship is not required, students must be levelal U.S. permanent residents or have applied for permanent residence (the application which has not been dealed) and intends to become a U.S. citizen at the actilast opportunity ellowed by law. (Foreign exchange students are ineligible.)

How Do I Get Started?

- Ask a teacher or youth group/club adult leader to supervise the Patriot's Pen writing context.
- Contact a participating VPW Post and indicate your interast in participating.

- Establish a contact person who is a member of that VFW Post or its VFW Auxiliary.
- Make sure that your easely is submitted to the VFW Post before the context deadline of October 31, 2024. You can submit your easely and entry form by enail upon the Post's approval. Entries sent to the VFW National Headquarters directly will be returned.

How Am I Judged?

Clarity of ideas is worth 55 points:

Write your essay in an easy-to-understand format. Leave your reader with a clear understanding of your explanation of the theme.
